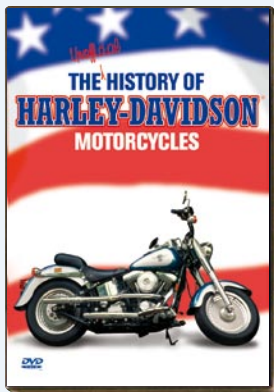


MORRIS MINOR COMMERCIAL VEHICLES

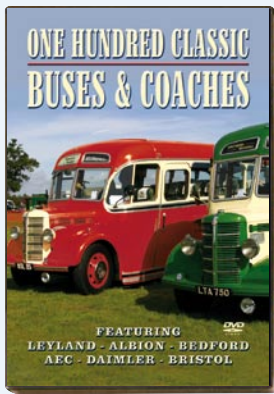


ONE HUNDRED MILITARY VEHICLES

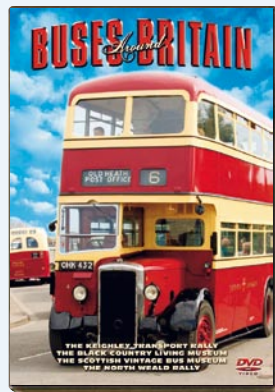


KEITH BEEDEN'S WORLD OF BUSES AND TRAMS 1960-1986

- The National Tramway Museum at Crich

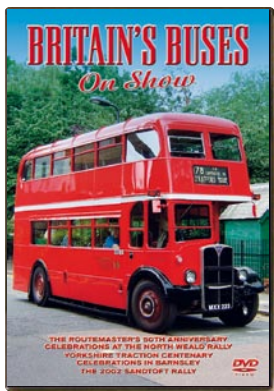

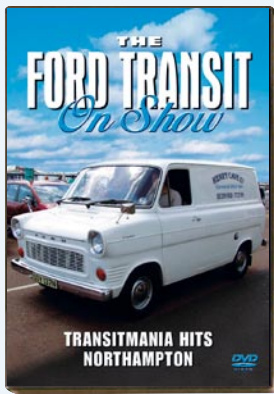


THE MG ON SHOW

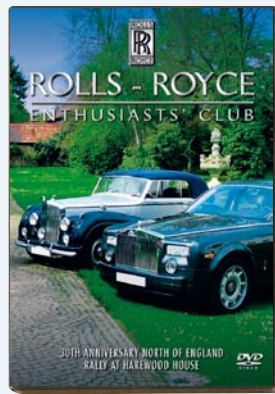




THE FORD TRANSIT ON SHOW

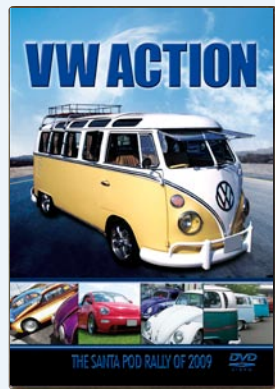


THE E-TYPE JAGUAR: A DESIGN ICON

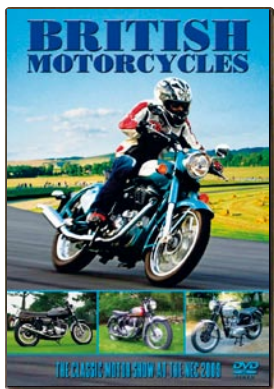
VW ACTION: THE SANTA POD RALLY OF 2009

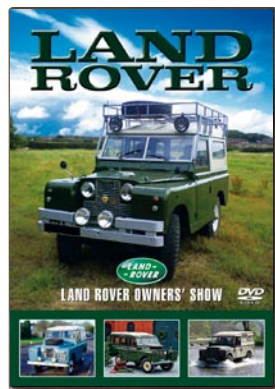

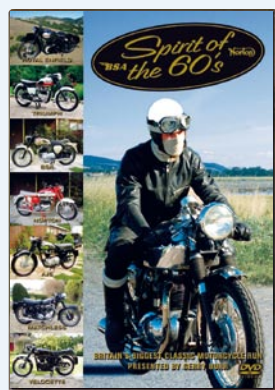

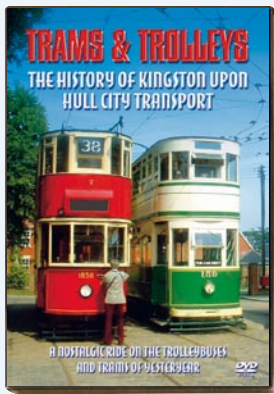


SPIRIT OF THE 60'S
